The Mutual Learning Fellow for Cultural Heritage Technology and Innovation will explore, experiment with, and research technology platforms to use for storytelling, presentation, and interactive experiences in exhibitions and on the Hood website. As an advocate for museum technology, the Fellow will help to make cross-departmental connections and work with other technology thought partners throughout campus to expand the museum's technological reach and capacity. The Cultural Heritage Technology and Innovation Fellow will acquire the skills necessary to continue learning to implement various technology platforms for cultural heritage. The Fellow may also use those skills to pursue further education in other technological industries.

Throughout the tenure of their fellowship, the Cultural heritage Technology & Innovation Fellow may expect to:

- Participate in collaborative projects, shared resources, and discovery with other Mutual Learning Fellows in the cohort.
- Research cultural heritage technologies.
- Advocate for the use of technology in museums and cultural heritage overall.
- Engage in training/self-learning/peer-coding and review on new languages and current platforms used at Hood and potentially across Library for shared governance software, storage, and projects.
- Assist with the growth and organization of the Dartmouth College Cultural Heritage Hub (DCCHH) meetings and events.
- Help to increase access to Museum's collections and resources.
- Learn to evaluate technology platforms and align them with museum needs (i.e. user buy-in, platform testing, spec comparisons, etc.).
