

## **Hood Museum Board of Advisors Mutual Learning Fellow, Education & Public Programming**

The Education & Public Programming Fellow will learn the art of connecting museum audiences with the collection. In collaboration with a team of museum educators, the Education & Public Programming fellow will learn about and contribute to the practice of teaching with artwork, museum visitor engagement with art collections through public programming and events, and accessible interpretive practice.

Over the course of three years, the fellows will learn and engage in:

- Contribution to the research, development, implementation, and evaluation of digital interpretation initiatives for Museum visitors onsite and online.
- Development of content and provide support to Education, Academic Programming, and Public Engagement & Events staff, internal collaborators, and external partners to achieve visitor learning outcomes.
- Working with educators & curators to develop online collections resources (for teaching, research, public engagement)
- Reviewing existing interpretive content, organize, and update as appropriate.
- Supporting efforts to expand the production of accessible interpretive materials.
- Regularly reporting out on digital learning initiatives.
- Training docents on delivery of digital initiatives related to group touring.
- Collaborating with external relations, visitor services, digital content, and campus engagement to promote and communicate digital learning opportunities to current and potential audiences.
- Learning about museum teaching pedagogy through observation and instruction.
- Assisting as needed in staffing public and co-curricular programs.
- Attending some docent trainings.
